FINANCIAL ECONOMICS 2017-2018

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Course Content

This course provides an introduction to finance. In the first part of the course the emphasis is on time value of money and its applications, including capital budgeting. The second part of the course will be devoted to the fundamental theories of finance: Modern portfolio theory and the Capital Asset Pricing Model (CAPM).
